



# *Austrodanthonia geniculata*

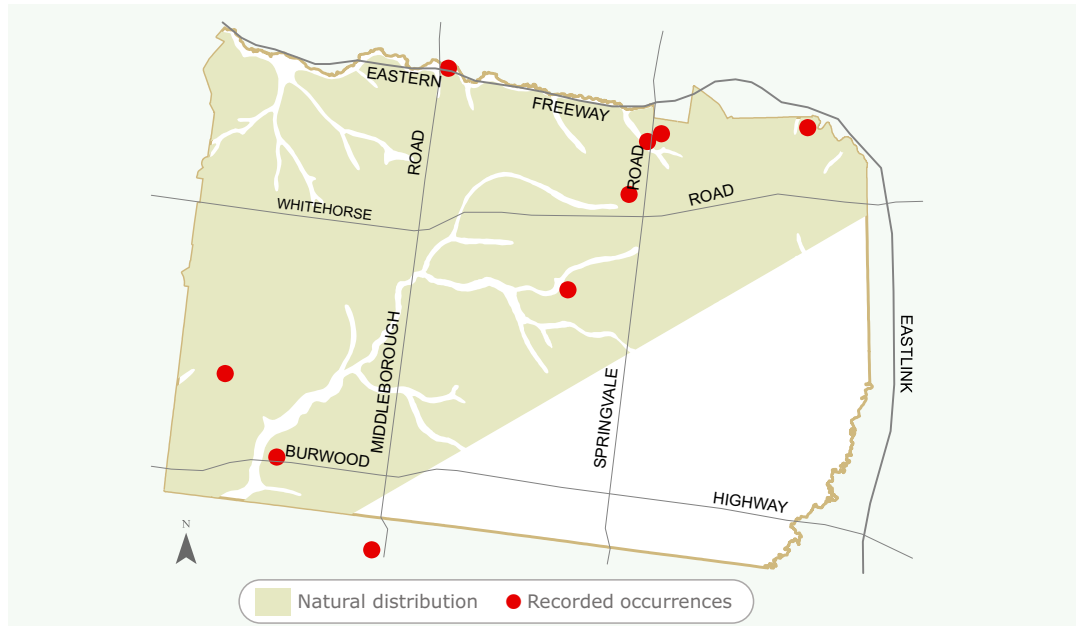
## Knead Wallaby Grass

<b>Height:</b>	15cm, stems to 30cm high
<b>Width:</b>	20cm
<b>Habit:</b>	Small tufted perennial grass with slender stems often bent near the base.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Fine bladed leaves that grow to 15cm long x 1mm with inrolled margins.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Compact purple grass-like flowerheads 1-5cm long in October to December and March. Mature flowerheads have a fluffy appearance.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Adaptable and tolerant to a variety of soils. Prefers a moist, slightly shaded position. Full or partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	Ideal for mass planting. May be useful as a lawn grass.

### Local Distribution:
