Veined Spear Grass

| | |
|--------------------------------|---|
| Height: | 40cm, stems to 1.2 metres high |
| Width: | 50cm - 80cm |
| Habit: | Spreading tufted perennial grass. |
| Foliage: | Erect inrolled leaves, woolly and slightly rough on one side to 40cm long x 5mm wide. |
| Flowers: | Green with purple tinged flowerheads, from November to January. |
| Requirements: | Prefers moist soils. Full or partial sun. |
| Cultivation & uses: | Useful for planting amongst trees or use as accent grasses. |

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is moderate.

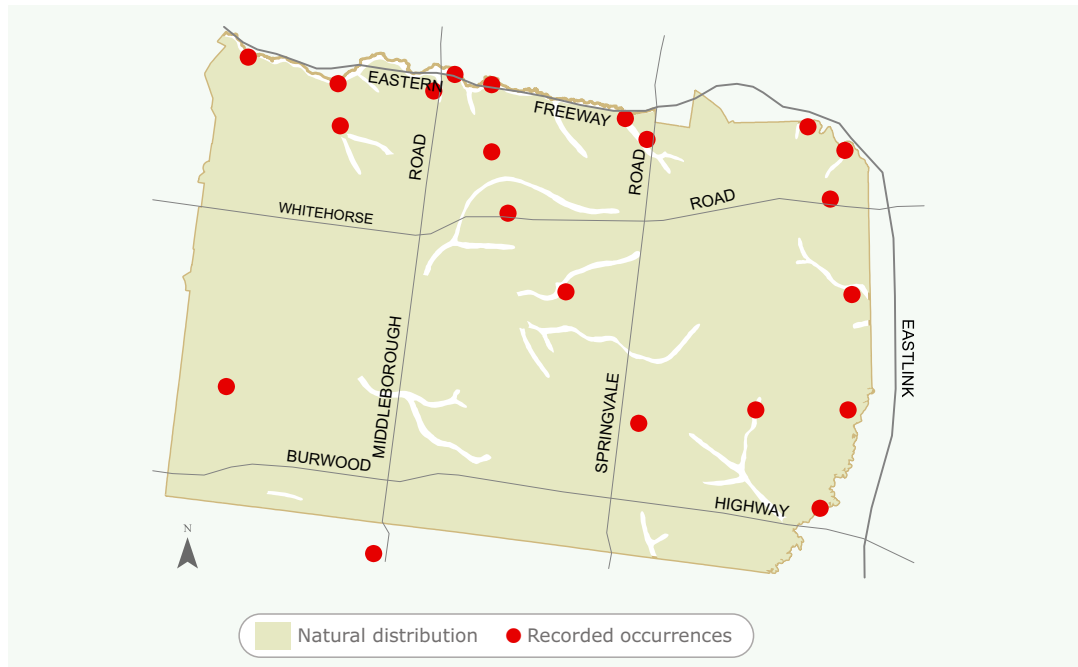
