



# *Carex appressa*

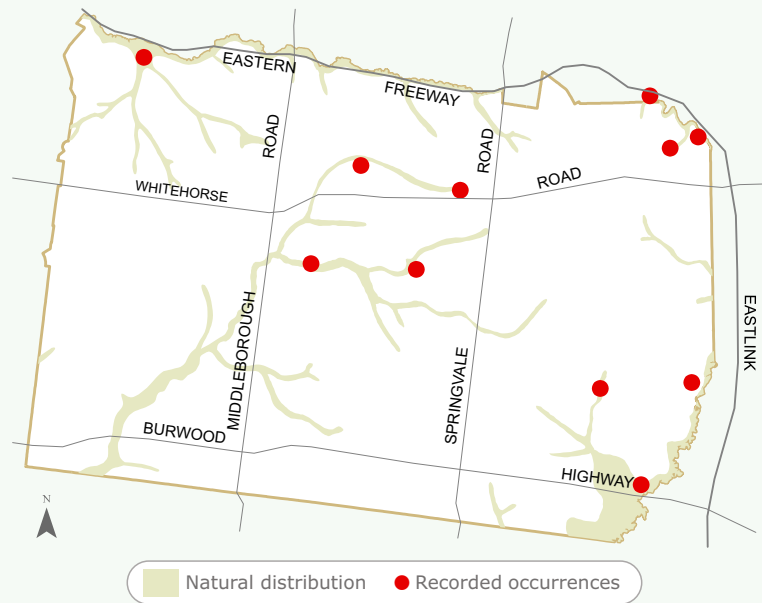
## Tall Sedge

<b>Height:</b>	0.5m - 1.2m
<b>Width:</b>	0.5m - 1m
<b>Habit:</b>	A robust densely tufted sedge, spreading from short underground stems.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Bright green slender arching leaves with rough edges to 6mm wide.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Long narrow brownish or dull yellow flowerheads on erect rough stems flowering from August to January.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Adaptable to a range of conditions. Prefers ample moisture. Full sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	A slow spreading ornamental tussock grass ideal as an aquatic or bog garden plant or effective in mass plantings. Useful for stabilising eroded stream banks or filtering impurities in streams. Tolerates frost and performs well through extended periods of dryness.

### Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is moderate.
