



# *Goodenia ovata*

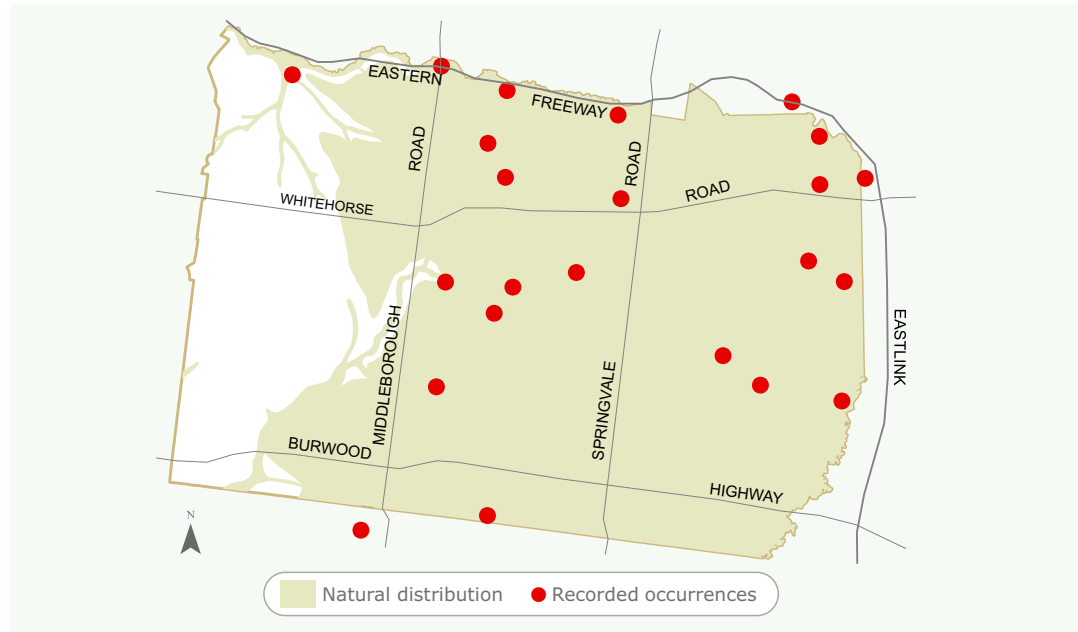
## Hop Goodenia

<b>Height:</b>	1m - 2.5m
<b>Width:</b>	1m - 3m
<b>Habit:</b>	Small to medium open to straggling shrub.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Light green oval shaped toothed leaves to 10cm long.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Small spays of bright yellow flowers, open and well displayed. Flowers from August to February.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Adaptable to most soils. Shade, full or partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	Provides a natural element to a bush garden. Pruning will avoid the plant from becoming straggly. Can be planted beneath established trees. Hardy, will tolerate periods of waterlogging.

### Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is moderate.
