

## Helichrysum scorpioides Button Everlasting, Curling Everlasting

A dense mat-forming perennial herb spreading by underground stems.

Clump of broad, soft, velvety grey-green basal leaves to 7cm long.

Single flat yellow flowers 2-3cm wide, surrounded by brown-yellow papery bracts like a daisy flower, held on long erect stems to 30cm. Flowers from September to December.

Well drained soils, preferring dry sites. Full or partial sun.

An attractive matting plant with a showy floral display, ideal for cottage gardens, rockeries or borders. Foliage dies back each year after flowering. Flowers dry well if picked young.
