



# *Juncus amabilis*

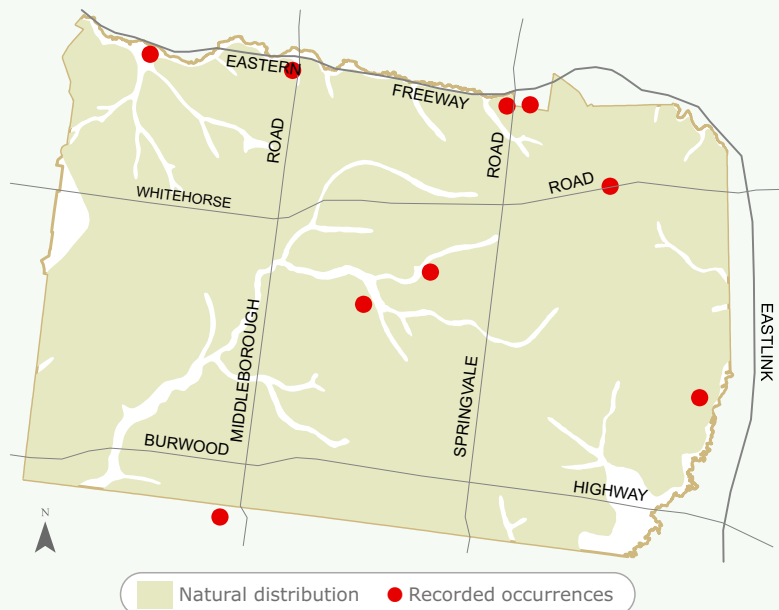
## Hollow Rush

<b>Height:</b>	0.2m - 1.2m
<b>Width:</b>	20cm - 50cm
<b>Habit:</b>	Tufted perennial rush spreading from underground stems.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Blue-green rigid erect stems with dark brown-reddish sheath-like leaves surrounding the base of stems.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Pale brown flowers clustered along the stems, usually on one side, from November to February.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Prefers moist soils, tolerating periods of seasonal inundation and dryness once established. Full or partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	Useful for wet edges such as ponds and waterways and for stabilising banks. Excellent habitat plant.

### Local Distribution:
