

## Juncus amabilis Hollow Rush

Height:

0.2m - 1.2m

Width:

20cm - 50cm

Habit:

Tufted perennial rush spreading from underground stems.

Foliage:

Blue-green rigid erect stems with dark brown-reddish sheath-like leaves surrounding the base of stems.

Flowers:

Pale brown flowers clustered along the stems, usually on one side, from November to February.

Requirements:

Prefers moist soils, tolerating periods of seasonal inundation and dryness once established. Full or partial sun.

Cultivation & uses:

Useful for wet edges such as ponds and waterways and for stabilising banks. Excellent habitat plant.

## **Local Distribution:**

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is infrequent.
