



Juncus holoschoenus

Joint-leaved Rush

Height:	20cm - 50cm
Width:	10cm - 40cm
Habit:	An open clumping perennial rush with leafy stems spreading from underground stems.
Foliage:	Cylindrical segmented hollow leaves often as long as the flowering stems.
Flowers:	Clusters of pale green flowers from November to March.
Requirements:	Prefers moist soils. Full sun.
Cultivation & uses:	An attractive common, widespread rush, colonising garden areas. Useful beside water features such as ponds.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is infrequent.

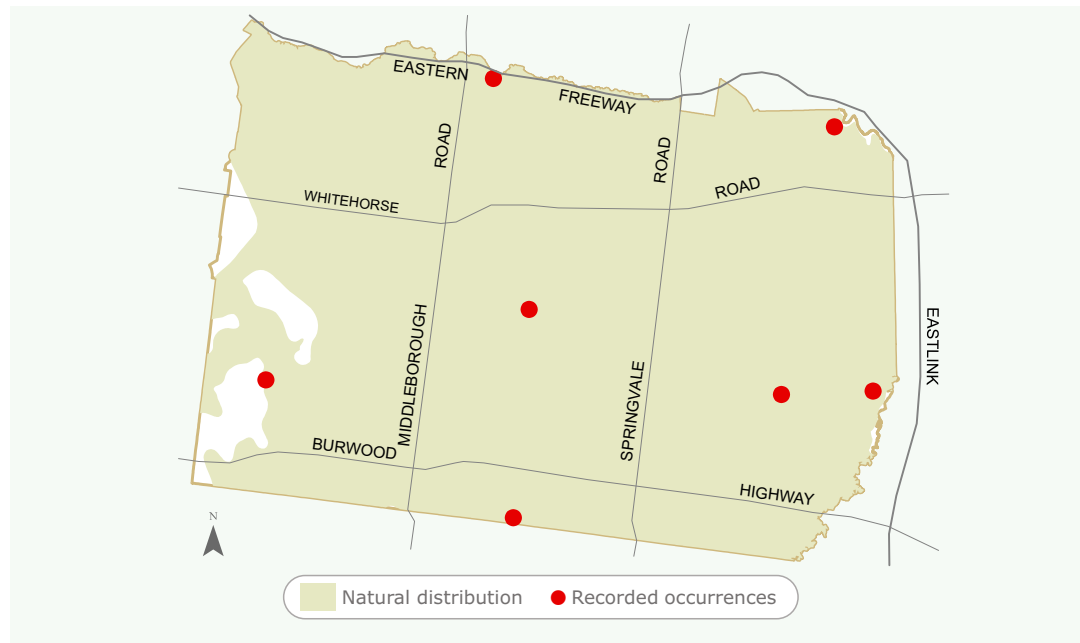
