

Myriophyllum crispatum

WHITEHORSE OPTIGHT WATER MINIO

Height:

25cm - 60cm

Width:

Spreading

Habit:

Aquatic erect perennial herb with bright green plumes that trail across the water surface.

Foliage:

Fine, feathery, fern or needle-like leaves with red colouring in cold conditions. Submerged foliage is finer and softer.

Flowers:

Cream to reddish-brown flowers produced along the stems from October to April. Yellow-brown to deep red cubic shaped fruit.

Requirements:

Moist to wet soils. Will grow in still or flowing water up to 1m deep. Full or partial sun.

Cultivation & uses:

Useful for in and around ponds, swamps and creeks. May be grown in completely submerged conditions. Provides good habitat for fish and frogs.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.
