



# *Myriophyllum crispatum*

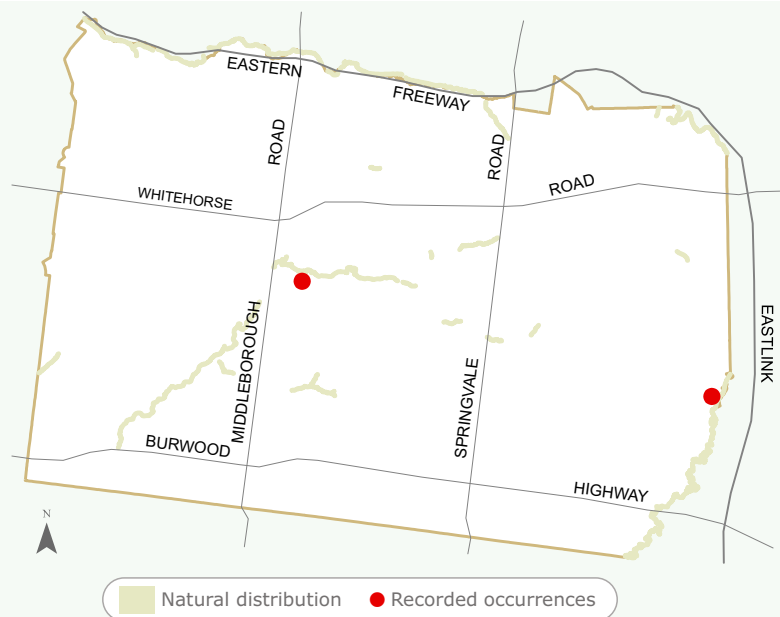
## Upright Water Milfoil

<b>Height:</b>	25cm - 60cm
<b>Width:</b>	Spreading
<b>Habit:</b>	Aquatic erect perennial herb with bright green plumes that trail across the water surface.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Fine, feathery, fern or needle-like leaves with red colouring in cold conditions. Submerged foliage is finer and softer.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Cream to reddish-brown flowers produced along the stems from October to April. Yellow-brown to deep red cubic shaped fruit.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Moist to wet soils. Will grow in still or flowing water up to 1m deep. Full or partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	Useful for in and around ponds, swamps and creeks. May be grown in completely submerged conditions. Provides good habitat for fish and frogs.

### Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.
