



Olearia ramulosa

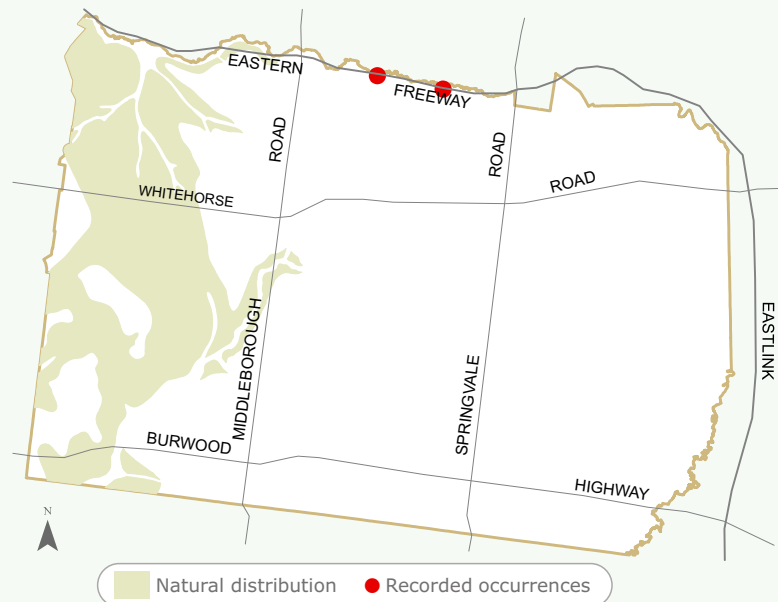
Twiggy Daisy Bush

Height:	0.5m - 2m
Width:	1m
Habit:	Open spindly, often sprawling, shrub.
Foliage:	Dark green, tiny, crowded oblong leaves to 8mm long.
Flowers:	Masses of small, white or mauve daisy flowerheads along branches from September to May.
Requirements:	Well drained soils. Full or partial sun.
Cultivation & uses:	An attractive plant growing well as an understorey beneath existing trees. Pruning encourages a less spindly habit.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.
