



Pimelea humilis

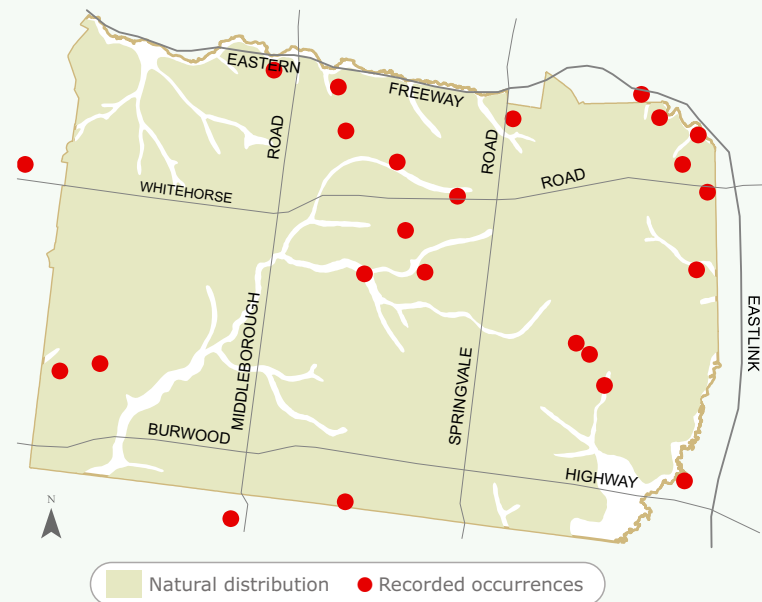
Common Rice Flower, Small Rice Flower

Height:	10cm - 50cm
Width:	30cm - 60cm
Habit:	Erect or straggling perennial shrub, with a lightly suckering habit.
Foliage:	Narrow green to grey-green leaves to 15mm long.
Flowers:	Clusters of dense white to cream flowerheads from September to January.
Requirements:	Adaptable, well drained soils, preferring moist sites. Full or partial sun.
Cultivation & uses:	Attractive small shrub, ideal for rockeries, borders and containers. May be established under trees and shrubs. Will tolerate dryness once established, but requires summer moisture.

Local Distribution:

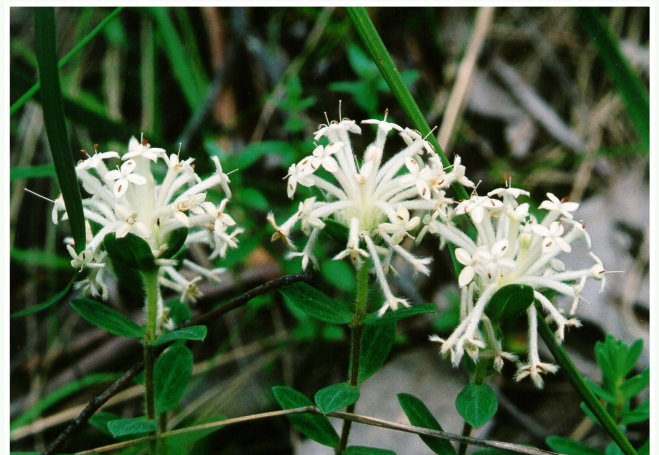
Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.
